Milking help for farmers

A FORMER poultry farmer who lost his farm to drought seven years ago is fighting back to support Australian farmers having recently taken over the reins as the local milkman.

Steve Moncur is delivering fresh Australian-produced milk to the doors of Caroline Springs, Kings Park, Albanvale, Ravenhall, Deer Park, Burnside, Brimbank Gardens and Cairnlea residents.

"I farmed free range chicken, duck and quail until seven years ago when drought forced me to give up my farm," Mr Moncur said.

"When I was given the opportunity to own a business that is 100 per cent Australian and to play my part in helping local farmers, I jumped at the opportunity."

Aussie Farmers Direct's range includes milk, bread, eggs, cheese, bacon, butter, coffee, water, tortillas and juice.

Deliveries are made overnight and placed into cooler bags left out on customers' doorsteps before 7am. Fruit and vegetables are delivered in boxes in the afternoon.
