Farm food a hit

THE milkman is back in Boroondara.

Parents from Ashburton Primary School, Solway Primary School, Ashwood Children's Centre and Rowen Street Kindergarten are signing up to receive home-delivered Australian-grown produce to support struggling farmers and their school communities.

Ashburton mother-of-two Barb Stephenson said she joined the Aussie Farmers Direct School Fundraising Program several weeks ago.

Ms Stephenson said she had been receiving 100 per cent Australian-grown and

owned milk, bread and fruit to her door twice a week.

She said about 50 families from Solway Primary had already signed up to the program, aimed at supporting Australian farmers. She said the company also contributed funds to the schools that took part in the program.

"My family is from a farming background, so it's a really good thing to know you're supporting Australian farming industry," Ms Stephenson said.
